Thank you for taking care of the patient. As you may be aware the patient, may receive a reimbursement of the price of your services from Polish National Health Fund (NHF) basing on the EU Directive on patients' rights in cross-border healthcare.

In order to receive the reimbursement, the patient will need documents specified by Polish law. Please read through the list, and assist him/her in completing the required documents. Your help will be greatly appreciated, and will make it easier for the patient to get the reimbursement from NHF.

1.	Does the patient have the original of the receipt/invoice for your services? If not please prepare receipt/invoice.	<input type="checkbox"/>
2.	Does the receipt/invoice provide the data of the healthcare institution that it was issued by? If not please prepare receipt/invoice with this information.	<input type="checkbox"/>
3.	Does the receipt/invoice provide the date it was issued on? If not please prepare receipt/invoice with this information.	<input type="checkbox"/>
4.	Does the receipt/invoice specify the name of the patient that was being treated? If not please prepare receipt/invoice with this information.	<input type="checkbox"/>
5.	Does the receipt/invoice specify the cost of the provided services? If not please prepare receipt/invoice with this information.	<input type="checkbox"/>
6.	Does the receipt/invoice or other documents provided to the patient allow identifying the provided services according to ICD-9 and ICD-10? If not please prepare such a document.	<input type="checkbox"/>
7.	Does the receipt/invoice or other documents provided to the patient confirm that the amount was paid in full? If not please prepare such a document.	<input type="checkbox"/>
8.	Please provide the patient with additional information including a description of the provided services, date when they were provided and any other relevant information.	<input type="checkbox"/>
9.	Furthermore, ask the patient whether he received a consent of the NFZ (Polish National Health Fund) for the treatment. If not then the patient will also need the original or a copy of the referral (document requesting an examination or a procedure). If you need an original of the referral please provide the patient with a copy.	<input type="checkbox"/>
